The chair of Statistics and Econometrics at the School of Business, Economics and Society at Friedrich-Alexander-Universität Erlangen-Nürnberg invites applications for a position as

## Postdoc in Empirical Macroeconomics or Time-Series Econometrics (Wissenschaftliche(r) Mitarbeiter\*in, salary scale TVL E13, 100 %)

starting on February 1, 2024. The position is initially for three years with a possible extension for another three years. There is also the option to convert the position to a temporary civil servant position (A13).

Our team's research focuses on issues related to macroeconomic expectations (in particular analyses using survey data) and time-series econometrics (mostly related to macroeconomic forecasting, including applications of machine learning methods). While experience in one of these fields is considered a beneficial qualification, we welcome applications from related fields.

We offer the opportunity to join a young and research-focused team that provides sufficient funding for attending conferences or visiting coauthors. Our department has close contacts to other institutions such as the IAB in Nuremberg or the ifo Institute in Munich, which provide valuable data access. Candidates will have the opportunity to pursue their own research agenda and to develop their own Bachelor or Master courses.

Candidates must have a completed dissertation in empirical macroeconomics, econometrics, or statistics. (We will not consider applications from candidates with unsubmitted theses and scheduled defense dates after December 2023.) Candidates should have a strong publication record or potential to publish in international, peer-reviewed journals. They should have excellent English and German skills (due to teaching obligations). Teaching experience in the area of statistics or econometrics is beneficial.

The position is full time (100%) and comes with the standard teaching load of 5 hours per week (for approximately 30 weeks per year). The working and teaching place is Nuremberg, with some possibility for remote work on non-teaching days.

September 2023 with a short letter of motivation (max 1 page), a CV including a publication list, and, if applicable, material to demonstrate skills or experiences (e.g., papers, PhD thesis, etc.).
